LAGGERS CHOICE IS A "PICK YOUR POISON" FORMAT!! 3 PLAYERS/WEEK, \$10/PLAYER, \$30/TEAM WEEKLY

- The Home Team has the option of putting up the first player to play or allowing the Visiting team to put up first.
- Once it has been determined which team puts up the first player, players will lag and the winner of the lag either selects the game format (8, 9, or 10 ball), or chooses to break.
- Race determined electronically by matching skill level of each opponent.
- Players matched up in match 2 and 3 also lag at the beginning of the match to determine who breaks and which game is going to be played.
- 20 team pts for shutout win, 14 team pts for all other wins, 1 pt for shutout loss, 3 pts for all other losses
- Bonus team points for Snap on Break, Break and Out, and Rackless

8 BALL RULE RECAP

- Table is always open after the break.
- Call ball, call pocket on all shots.
- Safeties allowed in NAPA 8 ball.
- If you scratch while shooting the 8 and do NOT make the 8, it is ball in hand for the opposing shooter and not automatic loss of game.
- All other scratches on the 8 are loss of game. Potting the cue ball and 8 on break is loss of game.
- Scratch on the break is ball in hand behind the headstring, scratch on all other balls is ball in hand anywhere on the table.

9 BALL RULE RECAP

- Shoot 1-9 in rotation, whoever makes 9 in called pocket wins.
- Slop is good except for the 9. 9 Ball is ALWAYS call pocket.
- Push shots allowed immediately after the break
- All scratches are ball in hand anywhere on the table
- No need to call safeties-make a ball, continue shooting, miss a ball, loss of turn

10 BALL RULE RECAP

- Shoot 1-10 in rotation, whomever makes 10 in called pocket wins.
- Call ball, call pocket on all shots-NO SLOP-Always call the 10 ball.
- Only 1 ball may be called per shot.
- Push shots allowed immediately after the break.
- No Called Safety Shots in Napa 10 Ball—make called ball, continue shooting, miss called ball, loss of turn
- Play Option—If you illegally pocket any ball, your opponent has the option of playing the table as is or requiring you to shoot again.
